Voyageurs League

The Voyageurs League was founded by Therese Morin in 1972 and staff from the St. Louis Residence, a long-term care facility in Orleans. The league began at the Normandie lanes. Larry Charbonneau, a founding member who is still bowling, searched to get a sponsor to provide trophies and found the Voyageur car dealership to help; hence the league name. The Voyageur dealership later changed its name to Belanger and moved to Rockland.

The League moved to the Orleans Bowling Centre in 1989 where it expanded from 8 teams at the Normandie to 14 teams currently. The league executive has been very stable with Larry being the Treasurer since the beginning, Gil Gerard the Statistician since 1978 and Carole Laplante the President for more than a decade.

This mixed league has had members compete in the O5PBA. Gil has bowled on Open teams. Frank Jerome had a 250+ O5PBA average. In the 1990's a team from the league made it to the Holiday Classic Provincial Finals. That team consisted of Frank, Conrad Serrurier, Micheline Shannon, Erica Brazeau and Roger Senechal; Conrad and Micheline still bowl in the league. The Provincial finals were held at the Orleans Bowling Centre that year and the team won their division, besting 5 teams in match play format, before losing in the semi-finals.
